WHERE OUR FIREFIGHTERS CALL HOME.

There are 106 fire stations in the City of Los Angeles. Each station is as unique as the neighborhoods its members serve.

The buildings themselves, and everything within withstands substantial wear and tear. Besides being tight on space, older stations require considerably more maintenance and repairs than their newer counterparts.

Firefighters work in 24-hour shifts. This means everyday kitchen essentials, laundry appliances, and exercise equipment sustain use around the clock.

WHY YOUR SUPPORT MATTERS.

Approximately 97% of the Department's budget is allocated to personnel expenses, leaving just 3% to cover the department's other basic needs.

When an appliance, ceiling fan, or coffee maker breaks down, our firefighters are out of luck. Budget constraints and limited resource availability result in firefighters frequently shouldering the costs for repairs or replacements of basic items.

Firefighters are resourceful and when something breaks, they have a natural inclination to fix it, take out a loan to replace the item, or seek help from the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) Foundation.

ABOUT THE ADOPT-A-FIRE STATION PROGRAM.

The Adopt-a-Fire Station program (AAFS) is your opportunity to directly support the firefighters of your community.

This program enables communities to give back to their local station, and to say thank you for the selfless service these men and women provide each day.
